Event Overview

The *Eventers Challenge* is a course of show jumps followed by a round of knock-down, cross-country style fences.

All cross-country rounds will include two water complexes and classes 3 & 4 is to also include steps.

Both the show jumping and cross-country will be against the clock. Time faults will be added for any refusals or knock-downs. Any more than two refusals in either the show jumping or cross-country will result in elimination.

All rosettes are to 6th place.

All riders must wear body protectors and skull caps (no fixed peak) to current standards as well as a medical arm band on the day.

The course will be open for walking the evening prior to the event (times to be confirmed). The course may also be walked, on the day, prior to the class starting.

Class 1. 60cm – Approx. 9:30-10:30am Horses/ponies – not to have won 49 points or £49 (notional) prize money in BS, not to have earned any BE points or more than 49 BE Foundation points (or none within the past 3 years from 30th September 2019). Combination not to have won at 90cm or above. Riders not to have won BS classes at 1m or above; not to have won at BE 100 or Pony Club Area Intermediate Eventing or Show Jumping or above.

Class 2. 70cm - Approx. 11-12pm Same rules as class 1.

Class 3. 80cm – Approx. 12:30-1:30pm Horses/ponies – not to have won 99 points or £99 (notional) prize money or points in BS or more, not to have earned 10 BE points or 99 BE foundation points (or none within the past 3 years from 30th September 2019). Combination not to have won at 1m or above. Riders not to have won BS classes at 1.10m or above; not to have won at BE Novice or Pony Club Open Eventing or Show Jumping or above.

Class 4. 90cm – Approx. 2-3pm Horses/ponies – not to have won 149 points or £149 (notional) prize money in BS or more; not to have earned 20 BE points (or none within the past 3 years from 30th September 2019).

The Sunshine Tour Eventers Challenge
Championships are set in the beautiful Sussex
countryside at the All England Jumping Course,
Hickstead on Sunday 15h September 2019. The
course consists of a mix of iconic Hickstead show
jumps and natural, rustic obstacles and
championship classes range from 60cm to 1m.

Rules & conditions of entry

- 1) The organisers of Priory Court Farm reserve the right to: Refuse entry without stating a reason, eliminate at any time during the competition any horse which, in the opinion of the steward, is unfit, ill or injured, and cancel the event or any class.
- 2) All riders must wear riding hats to current standard when competing. Hats must be worn at all times when mounted with chinstrap fastened.
- 3) In the event a fall of horse/rider, the rider must report to the Medical professional and organisers, prior to leaving the showground. An accident form MUST also be completed before leaving.
- 4) All dogs must be kept on a lead & any fouling cleared. All animals & children to be kept under control at all times.
- 5) The organisers accept no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to any competitor, horse, spectator or cars and property, whether caused by negligence or any other way arising from this event.
- 6) All competitors participate at their own risk. Everyone must take reasonable care to avoid & prevent accidents, & must obey all rules & instructions of officials at all times. The organisers have taken all precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone who uses the showground.
- 7) Any person to be seen riding dangerously will be asked to leave the course. Excessive use of whips/spurs will not be allowed.
- 8) There is a qualified first aider on site to provide pre-hospital treatment during this event if required. All competitors confirm that they are fit to compete, and that they consent to any treatment which may be given, advised or offered by the first aider.
- 9) All cars and horseboxes to be parked in designated areas. All areas must be left tidy. Please do not muck out boxes on site, and take your litter home with you.
- 10) **Events are being photographed, and by attending & signature on entry form, you are giving permission for Priory Court Farm to use these images without exception. This may be in magazines, websites and social media* Only the official photographer is permitted to sell images of this event.
- 11) The judge's decision is final. Acceptance of the above rules shall be a condition of entry.
