**Ring 1. Start - 9am**

**Class 1.** Condition & turn out - ridden or in-hand.

**Class 2.** Ridden cob (to inc. show cob and traditional cobs).

**Class 3.** Riding club horse or pony (class may be split).

**Class 4.** Ridden coloured (to inc. dun, palomino and spotted).

**Class 5.** Ridden mountain and moorland.

**Class 6.** Veteran ridden (Horse age 15 and over class may be split into age groups).

**Class 7.** Ridden hunter - horse or pony (class may be split).

**Ring 2. Start at 9am**

**Class 8.** In-hand veteran (Horse age 15 and over).

**Class 9.** In-hand cob (to include show cob & traditional cob).

**Class 10.** In-hand “youngster” (ages 1-3).

**Class 11.** In-hand coloured

(to include palomino, dun & spotted).

**Class 12.** In-hand Mountain and moorland

**Pre-entry: £8 per class | On-the-day entries: £10 per class.**

**Placing: 1st - 6th place | Qualifiers: 1st – 4th place.**

**Ring 3. Start at 11:30am**

**Class 13.** Child handler in-hand (under 12 years).

**Class 14.** Handsomest gelding - ridden or in-hand.

**Class 15.** Prettiest mare - ridden or in-hand.

**Class 16.** Horse / pony judge would most like to take home.

**Class 17.** Lead rein / first ridden (10 years and under).

**Class 18.** Best rider (under 16).

**Class 19.** Family horse or pony (class may be split).

**End of day championship for everyone placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

### Rules & conditions of entry

- 1) The organisers of Priory Court Farm reserve the right to: Refuse entry without stating a reason, eliminate at any time during the competition any horse which, in the opinion of the steward, is unfit, ill or injured, and cancel the event or any class.
  - 2) All riders must wear riding hats to current standard when competing in the show rings, both in hand and ridden classes. Hats must be worn at all times when mounted with chinstrap fastened.
  - 3) In the event a fall of horse/rider, the rider must report to the Medical professional and organisers, prior to leaving the showground. An accident form MUST also be completed before leaving.
  - 4) All dogs must be kept on a lead & any fouling cleared. All animals & children to be kept under control at all times.
  - 5) The organisers accept no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to any competitor, horse, spectator or cars and property, whether caused by negligence or any other way arising from this event.
  - 6) All competitors participate at their own risk. Everyone must take reasonable care to avoid & prevent accidents, & must obey all rules & instructions of officials at all times. The organisers have taken all precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone who uses the showground.
  - 7) Any person to be seen riding dangerously will be asked to leave the showground. Excessive use of whips/spurs will not be allowed.
  - 8) There is a qualified first aider on site to provide pre-hospital treatment during this event if required. All competitors confirm that they are fit to compete, and that they consent to any treatment which may be given, advised or offered by the first aider.
  - 9) All cars and horseboxes to be parked in designated areas. All areas must be left tidy. Please do not muck out boxes on site, and take your litter home with you.
  - 10) \*\*Events are being photographed, and by attending & signature on entry form, you are giving permission for Priory Court Farm to use these images without exception. This may be in magazines, websites and social media\* Only the official photographer is permitted to sell images of this event.
  - 11) The judge's decision is final. Acceptance of the above rules shall be a condition of entry.
